

## Before you start:

- Your Hire GoPro Hero 7 has been Setup, fully charged and a 32GB card installed.
- There is approx. 1 hour filming time.
- There is a Charging Station on the Vessel.
- Download the GoPro QUIK app if you wish to download your data at the end of the tour.
- Avoid using the QUIK App to control the camera as this will reduce your battery life.

#### Тар

Selects an item, turns a setting on or off.



#### Swipe Left or Right

Switches between Video, Photo, and Time Lapse modes.



Swipe Down From the Edge of the Screen Open the Dashboard when your camera





Swipe Up From the Edge of the Screen See your videos and photos in the Media Gallery.



Press and Hold

Turn on and adjust Exposure Control.

# VIDEO or PHOTO TIMELAPSE?



Your GoPro has three main capture modes: Video, Photo, and Time Lapse Video.




Change modes by swiping left or right to the one you want.

**PRO TIP:** Though your GoPro is waterproof, the touch screen won't work under water. With the camera on, you can press the Mode button to switch modes.

**PRO TIP:** You can zoom in to help eliminate the fisheye look around the edge of your video.

Heads Up: The screen will sleep after 1 minute of recording to save power. Tap the screen to turn it back on. It will wake for 10 seconds before going back to sleep.



## Getting your footage



**Download the FREE GoPro QUIK** 

**App** on your apple or android phone. You can then synch your phone to GoPro, to view, edit or share footage straight away! **OR** 





Request it via Dropbox or GoogleDrive our team will upload your footage to your preferred data storage site so you can download from the cloud. OR



**Go Plastic:** our team will make a copy for you on a **MICRO SD CARD** with adaptor, once you are back at port. This takes approx. 25 min once back at port.
